Statistics

- Treatment can reduce drug use and crime by 40-60%.
- Treatment can increase job prospects by 40%.
- Drug treatment is as effective as treatment for diabetes, hypertension, and asthma.
- Smoking is the leading cause of preventable death, accounting for approximately a fifth of all deaths.



- 75% of all people who try cocaine become addicted to the drug. Without help from cocaine addiction treatment or rehab, only 1 in 4 people quit on their own.
- Opiate use and addiction is linked to at least 50 percent of the major crimes in the United States.
- Approximately 50,000 cases of alcohol overdose are reported each year.
