The following are the approved codes to be used with the student learners based on the learner's learning, scope of practice and supervision. These approved codes are divided by discipline and, where necessary, level of education. All learners are to be supervised by appropriate practitioners with the required qualifications. Billing is always attributed to the primary supervising clinician. The billing code, with the modifier attached, to indicate that the service was provided by the student learner under the supervision of the licensed professional.

Student Intern - Individual who:

- Is a student in one of the following health profession training programs: counseling; marriage and family therapy; psychology; or social work which has been approved by the appropriate board, **and**
- Is performing the duties assigned in the course of training, **and**
- Is appropriately supervised according to the standards set by the appropriate board and the training program.

Social work student interns must be pursuing a master's degree in social work and be supervised by a Licensed Master's Social Worker in a manner that meets the requirements of the Council on Social Work Education (CSWE) accredited education program curriculum that prepares an individual for licensure.

Professional Counseling student interns must be pursuing a master's degree in counseling and be supervised by a Licensed Professional Counselor in a manner that meets the requirements of the Council for Accreditation of Counseling and Related Educational Programs (CACREP) accredited education program curriculum that prepares an individual for licensure.

Nurse Practitioner student interns must be pursuing a master's degree in nursing and be supervised by a Qualified Mental Health Professional in a manner that meets the requirements of the Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education (CCNE) accredited education program curriculum that prepares an individual for licensure.
